If any exist should be in CI Staff.</p> <p>Para 4: Annie Goodpasture wrote a history of the Mexico Station for the Western Hemisphere Division <u>not</u> the White House. This history covers the period from the inception of the Station in 1946 to 1969. There is very little material dealing with the Kennedy assassination but a great deal of material relating to [redacted] and operations not related to the HSCA investigation. It is impossible to sanitize this tome and the "soft file" documents do not exist.
