The files of a predecessor organization contain an Overseas News Agency article, dated 9 January 1944 at Mexico City, which states that Daniel DUNO, a Metropolitan Opera singer who was then singing with the Mexican opera, was threatened by Minister NEUL HW of the Polish Legation in Mexico City with withdrawal of his Polish passport if he took part in a concert sponsored by the Aid to Russia Committee. DUNG at that time was under contract for concert tours in several Latin American countries.
