Visit to Mexico of an Agent of the Cuban Government.

1. In late January 1960 meetings were held between Juan VALDES Carbalosa, <sup>cit Cuba</sup> members of the diplomatic staff of the Cuban Embassy and members of the Partido Comunista Mexicano (P.C.M. - Mexican Communist Party). Others who attended these gatherings were <sup>CIT - Dominican Republic</sup> Valentin FAYADA, a Dominican exile, Ida de la FUENTE, <sup>Cuba</sup> ~~HERNANDEZ~~, Violeta CASBALA, Ingeniero Jorge L. TAMAYO <sup>MEXICO</sup> Fernandez, a leading Mexican Communist, Luis ESCOBAR, Armando LOPEZ and Eugenio ARGUEL. The object of these meetings was to study plans brought from Cuba by VALDES Carbalosa for attacking various Latin American countries, including Guatemala, Nicaragua and the Dominican Republic.

2. On 26th. January 1960 VALDES Carbalosa left Mexico for Cuba via Guatemala. He stated that he would be returning to Mexico at a later date.
