[Redacted] in Brussels advised on 7 September 1948 that he had attended a cocktail party on 31st of August given by a Miss Aline MOSBY. He stated that Miss MOSBY works for North American Newspaper Alliance, is about 30 years of age, and had been fined for a wire tapping in the USA for having leaked information to Confidential magazine. He stated that she plays football with the Mustangs and is a co-ordinator type, stated that she is a very good writer and is employed as a stringer for KAU and that he had used one or two of her articles after rewriting them.

Miss [Redacted] in attendance at the party was one [Redacted] who has been known to [Redacted] during his temporary stay in Brussels.

[Redacted] who [Redacted] alerted Miss MOSBY's invitation to attend Miss MOSBY not to ask any intelligence type or KAU types to the cocktail party.
