HRHOLLY/8 was aroused and said that he would definitely get onto this matter. He then volunteered that a "Carmichael" had been in Lagos a few months ago and, upon questioning, he said he didn't know if it was "Stokely" or his then told him that this was a case in point and that if brother. he had any system of monitoring these people he could help us run down known criminals, just as we would help them run down any criminals that landed in our country. As noted above, KRHOLLY/8 seemed eager and willing to assist, but it is dubious that he will be able to make any real progress on his own or convince his superiors to make a concerted and formal effort to provide us with the information we would like to have, especially the follow-up locally of the activities of MHCHAOS people when they arrive and start moving around town. SOKOYA was Assistant Chief of Protocol before his present assignment and, according to the LNCUFF Assistant Political Officer, was very friendly and helpful to LNCUFF.
