1. THE 9,344 GRT SOVIET SHIP SLUTSK ARRIVED WITH ARMS IN MATANZAS, AND BEGAN UNLOADING IN THE AFTERNOON OF 8 DECEMBER 1963.
2. FIELD COMMENT: A USUALLY RELIABLE SOURCE INDICATED THAT ON 7 DECEMBER THE SLUTSK WAS AT POSITION N 26-24, W 75-06 AND HEADED FOR CUBA.
3. FIELD DISSEM: CINCSO, CINCLANT, COMNAVKEYWEST.
