He is known to operate at least four enterprises: 1) CAPITAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, a private detective agency; 2) REDEX VIETNAM, INC., a firm which imports a variety of commodities ranging from liquor to automobilies into South Vietnam, including, of late, U.S.-recruited "governments for a Saigon nightclub he is planning; 3) REDEX CONTINE A firm which sells almost anything to anybody abroad, other than Bouth Vietnam; and 4) CONSOLIDATED ARMANIENTS.
