1. Subject was born in Vienna, Austria, on 5 January 1920, to
Karel H.M., the father of 1911, and Rosa (nee K...), the
mother of 1911, high school, and attended school in Vienna, and at
18, went to work for the... with a steel com-
pany.

2. The couple crossed over in the following year with the...
and on returning to Vienna, met... whom she married in 1930.
The couple went to Berlin where... of a Communist paper.
Subject played on the German stage for about 2 years. After three years
of married life (during which time she had become a Communist and had
been active in Communist Party work) she and... separated.

3. Shortly thereafter, she fell in love with...
an American citizen, who... a Communist, and...
