You will be asked to sanitize these reports to protect intelligence sources and methods prior to transmittal to the Committee After sanitization, the reports will be transmitted to the Committee, classified, if necessary, at the highest level of classification appropriate.
- 4. (U) Advise me if you are unable to respond within a reasonable time or if you have any questions regarding our procedures for dealing with the Committee.
