1. Attached are photographic copies of the following documents:

- a) An agreement dated 29 November 1953 in which Eduardo Sabatino agreed to sell certain arms and aircraft valued at \$850,000. U.S. currency to Major Jose >  
Eduardo Montenegro Paniagua, an exiled Guatemalan army officer. Note: As of May 1954 Montenegro was in a Mexico City jail for failure to pay his hotel bill.
- b) A letter, or note, dated 30 June 1954 from Eduardo Sabatino B. to Robert >  
Alvarado Fuentes, for Guatemalan Ambassador to Mexico. There is no indication that this letter was mailed.
- c) A letter dated 22 March 1950 from the Chief of Police, Miami Shores Village, Florida, stating that Edward Browder, Jr., a resident of Miami Shores Village, is a law abiding citizen of that town.
- d) A letter dated 3 August 1954 from Edward Browder S. to Col. Marcos Perez >  
Jinenez, President of Venezuela. There is no indication this letter was mailed.
- e) A letter dated 3 August 1954 from Edward Browder to General Fulgencio Batista, >  
of Cuba. There is no indication this letter was mailed.
- f) An undated letter (probably July 1954) from Eduardo Sabatino B. to an un-named Ambassador, possibly the Nicaraguan Ambassador to Mexico.
- g) A letter dated 1 August 1954 from Edward Browder Sabatino to General A. Somoto, of Nicaragua.
- h) This document appears to be part of an agreement whereby subject will operate in Europe in behalf of an un-named government.


- i) This document appears to contain call letters for radio stations and cryptic symbols for certain countries.
  - j) This document contains rough drawings of bombs and grenades.
  - k) A letter signed Eduardo and dated 20 July (1954) at Guatemala City. It appears from this letter that subject may have gone to Guatemala City after his escape on 16 June 1954 from the custody of Mexican Immigration authorities. *to draft*
2. Edward Browder, Jr. has a long record for violations of the Neutrality Act and other federal statutes in the United States. His whereabouts since his escape from the custody of Mexican Immigration officials on 16 June 1954, is unknown.

En la ciudad de Mexico, D.F., a los 29 días del mes de Noviembre, 1953; ante mí notario publico como testigos quedaron los señores Eduardo Sabatino y El Mayor Jose Eduardo Montenegro Paniagua, d el Ejercito Guatemalteco, quienes son de mi conocimiento autores de derecho para celebrar el siguiente contrato:

- 1: El Mayor Jose Eduardo Montenegro Paniagua se compromete seriamente a comprar d el señor Eduardo Sabatino, un lote de armas incluyendo ocho aviones (cuatro del tipo transporte C-46 y cuatro del tipo combate P-47) ademas varias mas cantidades de carbines, granadas de mano, ametralladoras, bombas y paracaídas para todo. Este lote de armas consiste de cantidad conocida entre los dos señores en una lista aparte, y tiene valor de ochocientos cincuenta mil dollars (\$850,000.00 U.S.) Aparte de este suma hay que pagar para parte del Mayor Montenegro gastos para los pilotos Aliados quienes deben manijar los aviones. El Mayor Montenegro compromete a pagar la mitad de el precio de las armas al dia siguiente de la venida de Honduras de el Licenciado apoderado Sr. Carlos Aurelio Recinos, quien tiene en su poder la cantidad de dinero suficiente a pagar y para todo de los cuentos de este movimiento. La otra mitad de este suma a ser pagado en el Puerto de Cortes, Republica Honduras al desembarcar todo el armamento.
- 2: El Señor Eduardo Sabatino se compromete seriamente a entregarle al Mayor Montenegro este lote de armas incluyendo los aviones mencionado y a toda del otro que consiste en una lista en posesión del Mayor. También El Señor Sabatino compromete a ayudar al Mayor Montenegro en todo lo necesario para subir al poder y haber derrocado al actual Gobierno Comunista de Guatemala, hasta llevar a feliz término lo deseado.
- 3: El Señor Sabatino también se compromete a entregarle al Mayor Montenegro diez pilotos Aliados, expertos en la cosa mencionada y dos Jefes de infantería, y a ser dirigido de los Aliados en sus trabajos.



My Dear General:

I renew my intifury to complete my PLAN and return in MEXICO, CUBA, AND  
after your PLENARY action with your Ambassador in MEXICO is about my PLANE return  
to NICARAGUA. However, to you have no doubt been informed, I have been detained by the AIR  
of NICARAGUA in MANAGUA, ON SOME INFORMATION REGARDING INVESTIGATION OF A SOURCE,  
BUT NOT BEING UNDERTAKEN THE MORE TORNADAS, IN ONE OR SEVERAL VILLAGES. THIS  
DETENTION IS MOST UNPLEASANT ATTENTION AND ADDITION TO LEAVE THE COUNTRY. KINDEZ SAYING  
I HAVE, NEEDLESS TO SAY, WORK OUT ANY WELCOMING IN MEXICO, AS THEY ARE FURIOUS. FOR A RELEASE  
TO GET AWAY FROM THEM - I AM ASKING AGAIN MY ABILITY TO ARRIVE IN MANAGUA - I WAS  
SO DISAPPOINTED ON THE WAY TO AIRPORT TO MAKE THE PLANE TO MANAGUA.

THE MATTERS WHICH I DESIRE TO DISCUSS IMMEDIATELY WITH YOU ARE AS FOLLOWS: AMONG  
THE MOST UNFORTUNATE THINGS, AND MAY STILL BE, THE MOVEMENT AGAINST YOU, FINANCIALS, ETC. FINANCES - AND  
HELD BY JESÚS LÓPEZ - WHO WAS ON THE SIDE OF ARISTIDE, PURCHASE OF FOUR BRITISH MACHINES  
GUNNERS - TO USE IN POSSIBLE ATTACK ON YOUR RESIDENCE. THESE PLANS WERE OBTAINED written  
OUTLINE OF ARMED AND AMMUNITION, WHILE SERVING IN MEXICO. DUE TO EFFORTS OF DR AGUILERA - AND  
MY CONTACT, COM. GUERRILLA, ALL OF WHICH YOU KNOW. AND JESÚS LEFT TEQUILA MIDWAY. I HAVE  
LOST SOME OF MY INFORMATION DUE TO MY RECAPTURE FROM MEXICO - BUT HAVE NOISE - YES,  
INCREDIBLE, NEAR JESÚS IS IN MONTREAL. YOU KNOW OF CALLEJO DON; HIS CLAIMS TO BE ACTING ON  
BEHALF OF DR LÓPEZ - BUT I HAVE DIRECT EVIDENCE OF HIS WORKING CONTINUOUSLY FOR LIBERATION. THIS IS UNBELIEVABLE  
WILL POSSIBLY BE DELAYED FOR SOME DAYS ALTHO I MADE A CONTACT WITH HIM AND HE IS OF THE LIBERATION  
AND ACTUALLY CONTACTED FOR.

THE OTHER MATTER INVOLVED HEREIN DON JOSÉ - WHO HAS BEEN HIT, THUS WHILE THE BOMBING WE'RE  
REVIEWING TWO UNCONTAMINATED SOURCE, TWO AIRCRAFT (A-20 - BOMBER, AND BOMBER) AND 105 UNARMED  
WE'RE TO USE AMERICAN, WHICH IS A SURPRISE TO ME YOUR RESIDENCE. THIS IS THE INFORMATION  
WERE VOLUNTEERED TO ME BY ONE IN THE PILOTS ASSOCIATION FOUND IN MANAGUA, BY AGENT OF DR LÓPEZ. I DREW  
THIS PLANS FORWARDED ALSO - MAINLY DUE TO INABILITY TO FIND PLANS IN SPANISH IN SPAIN. PROJECT

would be necessary to go to LAGUA to utilize the present supply and transportation in order to

The situation is such about now. Get a movement immediately. Building supplies, - And I  
have written to Puchong to send up to LAGUA by air and in, now to be distributed on the  
East Coast or Logia area. Let us rally the forces with one P-51 for main aircraft to enable them to  
have early command and control. I have also written to facilitate the medium transports and  
airfield patrols required to utilize in flights on the base to the proposed movements where we have  
not the Colonel but a pilot licensed - I CAN safely say that the Commander will get in touch with  
within a maximum of six weeks from commencement of building operations.

I have no team necessary, but they are located in a too distant port. And I would  
need to rework my port to land down in Logia area, and for such a small amount, it is  
not worth the effort of the trip. Much less the risk - - - Therefore, if you can arrange  
clearance for one of my planes to land at Puerto Lopez (ABO 24), and also parallel to move  
at Puerto Lopez, we can work there. I will send a PBY5A to pick them up in successive  
trips and lift teams to LAGUA by air in Logia area.

"chase" set to two PV.1s after their arrival. The PBY is available immediately upon  
receipt of your okay - AND THE OTHER AIRCRAFT CAN BE SENT AT 24. I will tell the Colonel  
that we men and supplies are ready.
