SUBJECT: Miro Cardona's Interest in Purchasing Arms

1. Miro Cardona recontacted Richard Cain on 30 August 1963 and urged Cain to do something to help him in locating machine guns, pistols and other arms and material to equip 50 men.

2. Cardona told Cain that Bueso (phonetic) in Miami is getting desperate for the arms and equipment; that some men have already been sent into Cuba and others are ready to go in. Cardona said that they have enough arms in a warehouse to equip about 15 men and desperately need the additional items. Cain told Cardona that he was unable to help him in any way since he had "lost his contacts".

3. Further, in connection with the conversation [redacted] had with Cain, Cain stated that he attempted to learn who was behind the arms purchases and included in Cardona's answer was the statement that "CIA will have nothing to do with it".
