SUBJECT: AMCORE/2 C-91333

1. It is requested that a FOA be granted on Subject.
2. AMCORE/2 is a news analyst. He writes and voices a 30-minute daily political analysis which is carried by Radio Station WBL in New York City. He is in no direct contact with any Agency staff employee, is handled by William S. WIBALDA, contact agent for Radio Americas, and is paid by Station WBL.
3. TFW/PA-PROP rates AMCORE/2 as a most effective political speaker, and reports from Cuban refugees interviewed indicate that Subject's program has a large audience inside Cuba.
