For some months ¹⁶⁻⁸ (the Station) has successfully intercepted George de MOHRENSCHILDT's personal mail, securely monitoring those letters indicated in DIR-41342, DIR-81595, and DIR-82820.</p> <p>2. The original purpose for intercepting DE MOHRENSCHILDT's ¹⁶⁻⁸ mail was to tell us Subject's correspondents outside Haiti. Today (the Station) has such an excellent list of names and addresses of Subject's worldwide acquaintances that current incoming letters almost always bear the same addresses previously reported.</p> <p>3. ¹⁶⁻⁸ (The Station) would like to know ¹⁶⁻⁸ if Headquarters has a continued interest in all of Subject's mail. If not, (the Station) will discontinue reporting previously reported addresses and will continue to monitor those letters from individuals noted in DIR cables mentioned in paragraph one above.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>William S.
