ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

1. One of the subjects which the writer would like to discuss briefly during his TDY at Headquarters is George DE MORENSCHILD. The undersigned would appreciate some advance inquiries at Headquarters prior to discussions on 15 March.
2. We are interested in knowing the degree of CE or CI interest in Subject. Since the writer knows DE MORENSCHILD fairly well, the undersigned could readily enter into a closer social relationship which would be certainly time consuming and would be in line of duty and not by the writer's choice.
3. We would also like to know the extent of U.S. agencies' desire to monitor his communications. Should we open any of his mail in addition to his correspondence with the two individuals cited in DIR-82820? What should we do with his incoming commercial cables? In case we learn that DE MORENSCHILD is about to make or receive an overseas telephone call, does Headquarters wish us to send an IMMEDIATE cable to alert U.S. agencies to intercept the call?
3. The definition of Headquarters interest in DE MORENSCHILD is important for Station planning. We do not want to waste time and effort on targets not of primary interest.
