SUBJECT: George de M. MCHRENSCHILDT (201-725439), contacts with Polish Commercial Delegation in Port-au-Prince.

1. Following information concerning George de MCHRENSCHILDT's contacts with the Polish Commercial Delegation in Port-au-Prince was provided by [EY] NOB-1. This report covers the period 14 September to 11 December 1964. Mr. MCHRENSCHILDT's past contact with the delegation has been reported in reference and several other reports.

2. Station notes that George de MCHRENSCHILDT or his wife Jeanne visited the delegation but once during the Polish Commercial Attache, Wladimir GALICKI's (201-31448), absence from Port-au-Prince. This one occasion was on 27 October, two days before GALICKI and his family returned to Port-au-Prince. On that one visit, Mr. de MCHRENSCHILDT was accompanied by an unidentified American. De MCHRENSCHILDT, the American, and the acting Commercial Attache, Casimir SALACINSKI (201-752851), stood together in the courtyard for about half an hour. The American was short, fat with greying hair.

3. 30 October (Day after GALICKI's return to Port-au-Prince.) Mrs. de MCHRENSCHILDT visit the GALICKI's for an hour during the day. Mr. and Mrs. de MCHRENSCHILDT have dinner with GALICKI's later that evening.

1 November GALICKI's have dinner at de MCHRENSCHILDT's.

9 November Mr. and Mrs. de MCHRENSCHILDT stop by for one hour and a half. They drink and talk with GALICKI's.

10 November Mr. and Mrs. de MCHRENSCHILDT and unknown American stop by for an hour. All speak Polish.

- 12 November: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT stop by office but GALICKI's are out so they leave.
- 14 November: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have dinner with GALICKI's. Stay for 1 1/2 hours.
- 16 November: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have dinner with GALICKI's. Stay for two hours.
- 19 November: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have dinner with GALICKI's to celebrate Mrs. GALICKI's birthday. Mr. and Mrs. SALAMSKI also present.
- 24 November: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have dinner with GALICKI's. Stay for 2 1/2 hours.
- 29 November: Mr. de MOHRENSCHILDT brings unknown woman to GALICKI's at eight o'clock in the morning. They have tea for 1/2 hour and leave.
- 1 December: Mr. de MOHRENSCHILDT and GALICKI chat for 1/2 hour.
- 3 December: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have dinner with GALICKI's.
- 7 December: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT arrive with unknown woman, have tea and chat for two hours. Woman speaks French, is white, tall thin, long hair and long face.
- 8 December: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT dine with GALICKI's. Stay for 3/4 hour.
- 15 December: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have two o'clock lunch with GALICKI's. Stay 3/4 hour.
- 19 December: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT have rum, tea and cakes with GALICKI's. Stay 1 1/2 hours.
- 21 December: Mr. and Mrs. George de MOHRENSCHILDT have tea and drinks with GALICKI's. Stay 1 1/2 hours.
- 24 December: Mr. de MOHRENSCHILDT brings an American couple with two daughters to see GALICKI. Both husband and wife are tall and thin. Party stays for 15 minutes.
- 26 December: Mr. de MOHRENSCHILDT brings two American men and a baby all of them wearing bathing suits. One of the men is bald, the other has short hair. Party leaves without GALICKI's after 10 minute stay.
- 29 December: Mr. and Mrs. de MOHRENSCHILDT stop by with friends and stay for 3/4 hour.

4. LEVINOR-1 cannot identify by name the Americans with whom the de MOHRENSCHILDT's have frequent contact and may introduce to GALICKI. ~~However, the identity of the two American men who visited GALICKI on 26 December maybe associated with the "Sam" reported in [HTPA-1463.22]. The unknown woman noted on 7 December maybe the "Alex" noted [HTPA-1461 paragraph 22]. The unknown woman visitor of 29 November maybe Verna SOMOFF noted in [HTPA-1449.22]. According to Pan American manifests Miss SOMOFF left Port-au-Prince at about 9 pm on the 29th of December.~~
