- 1. Reference is made to the request dated 12 July 1962, subject as above, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office. The files centain the following information concerning the subject of your request.
- 2. In July 1959, DIAZ was exfiltrated to the United States with the help of this Agency. A debriefing report dated 29 July 1959, Tampa, Florida, made following Subject's escape from Cuba gave the following biographical information:

Subject was born in 1928 to Pedro Luiz DIAZ Rivero (father) and Esther Linz Garcia (mother). He left Marianso High School in 1947 without graduating. He received private flight instruction at Santa Fe Airport in 1950. Subject had six brothers and two sisters who are listed with their ages: Sergio, 39; Quillerso, 25; Reinaldo, 23; Jorge, 22; Eduardo, 20; Pedro Luis (?); Yolando, 32; and Esther, 15. They were all listed as being in Havana with the exception of Sergio who was in the United States. Subject described his position as Inspector-General (equivalent to Deputy Commander) of the Cuban Revolutionary Airforce.

3. A magnily reliable source reported on 4 August 1959 that Subject was married to Emilia Alvarez Martinez de DIAZ Lanz.
