1. EARLY MORNING 10 FEB ANDIP-1 CALLED BENDER SAYING HE WOULD STOP SHIPMENT RECRUITS TO CAMPS WHICH ACCORDING ANDIP SCHEDULED TODAY. ANDIP-1 STATED THAT AS MATTER OF PRINCIPLE NO CUBAN CAN AGREE SUPERIORITY OF MILITARY OVER CIVILIAN AUTHORITY. ALSO PROBLEM CREATED BY UNILATERAL U.S.A. ACTION IN CONNECTION ANDIP-1 DISMISSAL MUST BE SOLVED. ANDIP-1 PROPOSES CANCELLING HIS TRIP TO CAMPS WOULD BE BEST SOLUTION.
2. BENDER TOLD ANDIP THAT ANY INTERFERENCE WITH RECRUITMENT OR SHIPMENT TROOPS COMPLETELY UNACCEPTABLE. IN FACT BENDER NOT PREPARED CONTINUE NEGOTIATE HIM WITH ANDIP UNDER THIS TYPE PRESSURE. BENDER SUGGESTED PATIENCE UNTIL RETURN HAMILTON WHO CURRENTLY GETTING FIRST HAND RELATING THIS SITUATION.
3. IN VIEW VERY HARD BENDER LINE ANDIP ENDED CONVERSATION WITH PROPOSAL TO INTERFERE IN SHIPMENT AND TO AWAIT RETURN HAMILTON'S RETURN TO U.S.A. NEXT WEEKDAY.
