INTRODUCTION. In order to more precisely clarify your responsibilities for AMSWIRL-1 the below listed information is being forwarded is an attempt to clearly describe the nature and scope of the activities with which we believe AkSkInL-1 should be associated. It is felt that a clear culineation of your responsibilities relative to AESATEL-1 as well as a restatement to ARSWIRL-1 of his mission on our behalf in the JEDAR area should minimize any possibilities that we might find ourselves embarraused by ANNAIRL-I's present or future activities. The below listed charter for ARSWIRL-1 has been discussed by Andrew E. BEUTFEAN with IDEA A, Supervising ODDOCA Agent, E ani, IDEA B, District Director of Chungh, and Kelvin W. Sholgov, Chief of Coa Locia. All of these gentlemen concurred heartily in this charter. This should insure that there will be a nininum amount of friction in the JEDAR arez in the future between ODUNGE, ODBOOM, AKSVIRL-1 and AUBLEK.

2. SCOPE OF AUSTIRL-1'S ACTIVITIES. It is believed that the following items clearly define the n-ture and scope of AUSWIRL-1's activities in the JKRIR area on behalf of KURARK. These activities are:

a. Collection of Priority Positive Intelligence. It is envisioned that America-I will Initial this responsibility by the timely debriefing of those refugees the enter Papping via the Jaria area. In this connection ANSWIRL-I must understand that he cannot get access to these individuals until they are at least primarily processed by ODURGE. Once ANSWIRL-I does gain access to a newly arrived refugee he is to skin off that perishable positive intelligence which may affect such items as the imminence of hostilities, the initiation of popular revolt or uprising, or

significant charges in PREUNIN's governmental or military structure. This collection effort is designed solely to obtain priority perishable intelligence, and it is not designed to replace, duplicate or compete with CAC.

- Departional Leads. In the course of Aksylid-1's debriefing of refugees for priority positive intelligence he should also assess these individuals relative to any operational leads which they might possess. In this connection he is only to identify such leads and then report this information to JETAYE by the most expeditions manner possible. This will insure that JEWAVE then has the opportunity to follow-up on these leads when the refugee in question arrives at CAC. Here again, it is important that akksylk-1 understand that he is a primary flushing mechanism, and, as such, he is to identify individuals who warrant a more thorough detriefing either by CAC or by JEWAVE. Under no circumstances is AKSYIK-1 to attempt to compete with or duplicate CAC's find exploitable operational leads.
- processes accoming refugees he chould pay attention to fishing boat personnel in an attempt to determine whether some of these individuals can be recruited and turned around in a matter of hours prior to the time that their departure from PRICEN will be noticed. If such a quich turn around lead is identified AMSWIGG-1 should utilize JERAR facilities for requesting assistance from JEWAVE to mount an operation with the prospective quick turnearound agent. If time does not permit JEWAVE's Tendering such assistance them at the discretion of Chief of Ease, JEBAR this lead can be followed up by JEBAR personnel as appropriate. In such operation at as early a time as it is possible to achieve.
- with the responsibility of attempting to spot CI suspects from among those PRECHEMS who either enter PEPPIME as refugees via the JMBAR area or who are already residents of the JMBAR area. It is clear, however, that AMSWIRL-1 only has a spotting responsibility with regard to this mission. Once a potential CI suspect is spotted no further action is to be taken on this matter by AMSWIRL-1 or JMBAR until such time as full coordination has been affected with JMFAVE. In most instances when this coordination has been affected the CI lead will be followed up by JMBAVE and/or JMBAR. AMSWIRL-1 will have fulfilled his responsibilities in the CI field at such time as he has brought the potential suspect to our attention.
- e. Procurement of Documents, scapons and Other Lelated Items. Aksyliki-l is also charged with the mission of procuring incoming refugees selected categories of high priority documents, wearcas and other related items. This procurement effort should, however, be kept to a minimum as too aggressive an effort in this field can complicate the refugee processing system at CAC. Specific guicance will be forwarded on a regular basis to JMBAR for passing to AKSWIRL-I relative to the types of documents, weapons and other related items which should be obtained on a priority basis. In addition to this list it is assumed that both JMBAR and AkSWIRL-I will exercise imagination, sound judgment and discretion in procuring other items which are of an obvious intelligence nature and which may appear in the JMBAR area on a target
- 3. SUPERVISION. AMSWEEL-1 is regarded as a JKPAR asset and the initial first echelon supervisory responsibility for AMSWEEL-1 clearly rests with JMBME. In view of this it is believed

that Chief of Base, JEBAR should be in direct contact with the senior ODURGE representative in the JEBAR area. EURARE requests to ODURGE in the JEBAR area should be handled by Chief of Base, JEBAR rather than by AMSTIRL-1. It is the intent of this dispatch to minimize the circumstances and occasions on which AMSTIRL-1 should be acting on behalf of LUBARE. The intent of the AMSTIRL-1 relationship is to utilize ODURGE cover for the accomplishment of a KUBARE operational support mission. This means that in those instances where AMSTIRL-1 surfaces his EUBARE relationship in order to accomplish his EURARE mission be is seriously defeating the primary purpose of our having worked out this rather unique relationship with ODURGE. It would be appreciated if you would bear this factor in mind in all future dealings with AMSTIRL-1 and the ODTOME agencies which are in the JEBAR area and who have an interest in the PREMENT problem.
