2. Source said helformerly belonged to the DRE, but after Plays
Giron it disintegrated. Nevertheless, he said, he was able to keep in
contact with a few DRE people who are in Havana. He said details on the

to the DRE group headed by a brother of Dlaz Lanz. This brother is still
in Havana. He said this group wants to engage in political assassination,
and has repeatedly requested that pistols with silencers be sent from
the United States.
