REVIEW

Despite reports and accusations to the contrary (INFO 3779), the Student Revolutionary Directorate is responding to KGB influence and control with increasing feasibility. Their withdrawal from the ASG-S coalition (INFO 2066) and subsequent condonation of prisoner release (INFO 2779) has been a morale boost for their clandestine organization within PRISONER as well as serve to their recruitment of BRENAK qualified support; namely, close scrutiny of funding, liaison and propagational infiltration of their agents, and depth of support for their independent maritime effort. While some 16 of their fully trained BRENAK infiltration agents are still watching the clock and boozing, the BRE Executive Committee has turned to the ASG-S project for some imaginative and effective operations.

1. ASG-S PROJECT1. Agents and Propaganda:

- a. Total number of candidates presented to date: 75
- b. Total number assigned: 40 (See attached Status List)
- c. Total assigned during April 1962: 3
- d. Total Financial Support: Subsidies: \$12,169.00 Operations: 1,513.00

2. Operations:

- a. By 9 April 1962, the radio network by ASG-S directed against the United States had been increased to 11 countries and totalled over 100 programs per month. (INFO 3779)
- b. Against 19 April, ASG-S estimates 15 countries now carry about 65,000 leaflets with a 50mm and address list for mailed areas mailing operation. (INFO 3811)
- c. Excerpt from Unidad Popular and reports from ASG-S Chile and Quiruvil: have indicated that each of the public interest and agitation for transition front is attempting relations with BRENAK the project lead by GARCIA against operations which began with the demonstration of 10,000 before the presidential palace in January. (INFO 6011)

4. On 23 April 1971, AMIA-53 and 60 reported that a flight of a Soviet MiG plane at the Mariscal Airport in Montevideo. This was covered over in the Montevideo station contact and WAVE is checking on this currently.
 5. Acting on Headquarters proposal (CIR 04025) to send a student info/prop through eight countries in preparation for forthcoming student congresses, an AMIA-53 team is preparing materials, documentation, itinerary, action plan and contacts for this tour. (WAVE 2014, WAVE 3027) 02
 6. During April, in Venezuela, [redacted] (in AMIA-53 station by station) and AMIA-53 (requested by station) conducted training and organization of section democratic youth in guerrilla warfare and anti-communist tactics. This activity is reported under station direction.
 7. In Ecuador, the "Action Anti-Communist Democracy" organized by AMIA-53 and 53 is now reported to total above 5,000 persons with distribution in 200 major cities in Ecuador. Participation into this binational group has reached the stage that DSE and WAVE prop is being translated and printed in the "Unidad Popular" daily.
 8. In Uruguay, the "Revolutionary Co-Recuperation Moral University" is organized by AMIA-53. It is located in the decentralized 11 faculties of the University in their struggle against the Communist dominated FEDU (Federación Estudiantil Universitaria) in Uruguay.

3. Fixes and Potentials:

- a. Financial support to the AMIA-53 project must be accelerated for operations. There is an evident lack of proportion between salaries and operational funds, especially in view of their potential as recognized by HQ, Task Force W and DIA/US.
- b. Station as a station has not recognized the necessity of assignment of less officials for AMIA-53 development alone. All station activities at present are assigned to the propagandist and the operational potential is neglected.
- c. When WAVE is properly staffed and AMIA-53 are full strength, the following potential exists:

1. Third country operations against the denied area for intelligence, espionage, and generation of international recognition to the AMIA-53.
2. Student and youth organizations with covert and cover activities designed to manipulate the central communist position in schools and universities of all Latin America.

II. ACTIVITIES

1. Imports and Processing:

- a. Financial support for ASIAT operations in PEKING for April consisted of \$7,000.00 sent in through the black market exchange. \$25,000.00 pesos have been received and are awaiting infiltration of ASIAT scheduled for 10 May 1952. During April \$725.00 was sent in \$25.00 money orders for funding families of ASIAT members in their departure.
- b. ASIAT courier a message to NIOB requesting a list of electronic supplies for two small radio sets and preparation of electronic detonating devices. NIOB is working on procurement of these items which are to be sent in partly in diplomatic pouch and partly in low infiltration operations.
- c. WIOB has processed ASIAT #7 as their second who is expected to begin training by the end of April. Subject is in the process of evaluation and LCFLUTTER.

2. Operations:

- a. ASIAT clandestine teams spent the first week in April placing block B-5 signs in Kuanon, Yuchow, Fortunate, to walls and cars.
- b. Also during the first week, a bomb was exploded in a Confraternity college setting fire to the auditorium.
- c. During early April a bomb was exploded in front of the Mariano Municipal Government offices.
- d. A report from their action team in Kuanon Province indicates their last cache of 400 lbs of C-4 plastic is almost exhausted.
- e. During the entire month of April, ASIAT infiltrators have worked along the north coast of Manchuria collecting operational intelligence for forthcoming supply operations. This information should be available sometime during May and June.
- f. During the third week in April, audit/drop teams posted B-5 signs on automobiles throughout the general greater Kuanon area.
- g. During the first two weeks, more than 10,000 copies of "Tien Tso" the official B-5 newspaper, were printed and distribution is now to all villages, Peking, NIOB and officials.

- b. 2000+ prop teams are operating 75% "C-mos" (handling certificates) in small concentrations for internal support.
 - c. A courier message requisitioning electronic banillas for small radio pieces and electronic detonators is currently being studied for procurement by ARIN and will be shipped in by diplomatic pouches and infiltration when procured.
 - d. ARININT action teams in Northern Matanzas are burying cans and homogum fuses using small candles as time delay igniters.

b. Training:

- a. ARININT-53 entered clandestine tradecraft training in preparation for his PARADE infiltration scheduled for about 10 May 1962.
- b. 14 Trained ARININT smuggling-infiltration in Miami have been procuring weapons locally and going out into the everglades area for small arms practice, and holding classes on general theory review of their training on sabotage, demolition and Guerrilla warfare.
- c. ARININT maritime section has a secure base at Miller's dock in Marathon where they have their SSUWID II berthed. They have crew quarters and have fully equipped the vessel with the exception of radar at their own expense. On 26 April, a thousand run was made from base to Gibara Key through Yaracuro and Cerdenes areas and return to base. All operations operated well and ARININT-40, 21, 43, and 47 were on as crew. If USAF supports for their operations is not approved it can be expected that they will make every effort to operate independently and without too vital coordination for such operations.
