: Conversation between President Loggs Hateos of Mexico and Kr. Winston Scott, Chief of Station, Mexico

- 1. This necorandom contains a suchestion, in Paragraph 3, for the consideration of the PCI.
- 2. On the night of 7 June, President Lopes Enters requested hr. Ecott to inform "his good friend, President Eisenhover," of the followings
 - A. That the President is a friend of the United States, "not only because of necessity but of Lenuine desire and ideology".
 - B. That the invitation to President Dorticos of Cuba was extended two weeks efter it was indicated that Dorticos was going to Mexico "on his own", through the Fexican Ambassador in Cuba.
 - C. That be will not invite Fidel Castro to Hexico even though Cuban Ambassador Jose Antonio Portuondo told President Leges Hateos that Dorticos will request an invitation for Castro.
- 3. President Loger Mateon also asked that President Eisenbover be informed that he is delighted that a decision has now been made to get rid of Castro. The DCI may wish to inform the President of the above.

h. President Lopes Nateos was indirectly informed of CIA intentions in remark to Castro through a conversation between Mr. Scott and

Lopes Mateos would not invite Castro to visit Mexico, even though Dorticos is Lopes it ask him to do so. Mr. Scott suggested that if the Mexican President helped JIA to schieve the overthrow of Castro, he would not have to deal with the problem of inviting Castro to Mexico.
