1. ~~Ricardo~~ ^{CIT: CUBA} **GUTIERREZ** Moneyo, former commander-in-chief of the Segundo Frente Nacional del Escambray (SFNE - Second National Front of the Escambray), plans to go from Habana to New York on a commercial mission involving tourism in the near future. **GUTIERREZ** ^{is} disturbed with Fidel CASTRO Rus, Cuban Prime Minister, because he is acting as though he thinks that he is another liberator like Simon BOLIVAR, and because he is taking all of the honors of the revolution, rather than sharing them with any of the other revolutionary leaders. The commercial mission has been given to **GUTIERREZ** as a sort of bribe. (Headquarters Comment. Representative Alan Clayton Powell wants to invite Castro to visit the United States. PRATJUI has said that this would be a big mistake as CASTRO probably would get audiences in the United States, the same way that Khrushchev did, and that such would turn out to be counter-productive to the interests of the United States.

(Field Comment. Source also mentioned that it was his impression that an invasion of Haiti by opposition forces would not take place in the immediate future.)

(Headquarters Comments. There have been numerous reports that CASTRO is supporting Haitian, Nicaraguan, and Dominican opposition groups.)
