<p>1. The picture under separate cover was taken at a Consular Corps luncheon at the Seurakuntotehdas Hotel in Helsinki on Wednesday, 10 December 1958. The individuals in the picture from left to right are: an unidentified Consul; G.E. Golub, Consul from the USSR; Costille; unidentified Firm; Virgil Elliot, departing US Vice-Consul; Iivari Alijoki, a Finn and Dean of the Helsinki Consular Corps representing Peru; M. Joris Bellens, Vice-Consul from Belgium; and Dennis Lindell, a Finn representing Honduras.</p> <p>2. During the luncheon Costille was introduced as the new Vice-Consul from the US. After the lunch Golub came directly up to Costille, introduced himself and asked Costille to join him at his table for coffee and cognac. Golub was extremely friendly and proceeded to ask the usual PRQ-I type questions, such as Costille's home in the States, how long he'd been in Finland, did he have a diplomatic title also, etc. Golub mentioned that his wife was in the Soviet Union and that he was living alone in his apartment.
