02 [VACCINE/Operations - VACCINE/1] comments on the [VAPID]
Torreyean Case

1. On the evening of 10 September [VACCINE/1] and his wife were at Brealey's home for dinner. It was supposed to be purely a social evening, and very little business was discussed. However, [VACCINE/1], who has been back from his five-week summer vacation for only one week, could not resist the urge to bring up the VAPID-Torreyean case. He said that he had read the interrogation report which had been prepared by one of his men and had subsequently talked to COLIS on COLIS's initiative. COLIS had called him and invited him to lunch, and they had met last Thursday. From [VACCINE/1]'s account it appeared that COLIS had described the incident at the airport quite factually, but VACCINE/1 placed very little credence in the accuracy of the account. He said that in view of the fact that the six American athletes were left behind to await visas, he could well understand that Torreyean had needed VAPID to 02
the point of compensation. He does not believe that anything further will come of the case. Certainly the Ministry of Interior plans to forget about it unless a new protest comes from the Soviet Ambassador.

2. Presumably, COLIS told [VACCINE/1] that VAPID had behaved stupidly in the whole affair and has been recalled to the Soviet Union. [VACCINE/1] says he has already departed.) COLIS also reported that VAPID is "married and expect man. Apparently the Soviets, or at least COLIS, do not believe VAPID's full story, according to [VACCINE/1]. The reason for this doubtfulness is that when the slapping incident occurred, VAPID had been speaking English to Torreyean. This report was evidently confirmed by the baggage master who witnessed the cuffing. COLIS thought it strange that VAPID, who speaks 02
Finnish well, should not use that language in speaking to Torreyean, who also has a fair command of Finnish.
