1. On 3 August Bramley had reason to see V.CCINE/1 for about three quarters of an hour on the subject of DIR-28837. After discussing this cable and before departing, VACCINE/I mentioned apropos of nothing at all that VANCUISHER/I had again been confiding in VACCINE/SO This time VANCUISHER/I said that VANCUISHER/I had remarked that the VACCINES have contact with the West. This, of course, is not at all surprising since VACCINE/I has maintained contact not only with the West, but with at least two Soviets as well, namely, Ivan EpiseRETEV and Grigory Year COLUB. The part that was surprising is that VANCUISHER/3 mentioned VACCINE/6 by name. VACCINE/I then went on to explain that VACCINE/6 had acted for him in a number of cases, in contact with the Norwegians and the Swedes for example; but all direct contact it. Finland had been carried on by (VACCINE/I) with very few exceptions D VACCINE/I continued to say that there may be some person who is talking out of turn at the Upseerikerho, and he intends to check the matter out with VACCINE/6.01

2. For a moment at least Bramley had the feeling that VCCINE/1 mentioned the above for his benefit, with the intention of pointing out that contact was to be saintained only with himself (V/1)) but as the situation unfolded, it became clear that this was not what was on VCCINE/1 s mind. He was apparently concerned that in one of the restaurants that they use, somebody may be reporting to the wrong people.
