the latest cases with some alarm. [REDACTED] reported his prediction that President ECHEVERRIA would effectively nationalize most private investment in Mexico before the end of his term.

3. The meeting was judged effective and afforded EICSY the opportunity to lay the ground work for his future relations with IDENTITY 2 members, while satisfying the guests' need for reassurance that our goals were parallel. They appeared happy with the conversations despite the informality.




