- 1. Zirayko mostalin Duki Nev, was burn o September 1926 in Felatica, Plovity.

 The finished pleven lergh my grades and jumastum in Plovity. He was a
 farmer. From 5 april 1950 until (La 1951 he served as a Trusvak in
 Bezner and palcik from where he described on 6 kay 1951. In company with the
 other Trusvaks, Stefan FIITEROV and Spas MAIKIN; Ivan and Petur MIKOLOV;
 Petur and Boris PELISHOV; he escaped to Greece and surrendered to the Greek
 euthorities on 21 June 1951. He is presently living in Laurion camp, Greece.
- 2. Subject was interrogated by MARAUNGIN, GALATIA, Draza Interrogation Center, ELSUR, UASP, and UASP/S. His story follows:
- in the Irudovak unit in Bermer, Jambol district, he became a close trion; o. Span solfill. Shots were planning to desert their unit and escape to furkey. Several other Trudovaks tried to sacape to Turkey have more caught. Later me was transferred to the Salcik Trudovak unit, steng with Kulill, where they became acquainted with Stefan HELTEKOV, who had planned to escape to Greece. PELTEROW was counting on the help of his brother—in-law, Vasil Lazer VV, a NEW in the Salmintry Regiment in Ploydiv, to as I in his escape. Since DARAGE and RAILIN at this point were unable to or, anize a sale escape to Turkey, they decided to join PELTEKOV and go to Greece, particularly since all three were from the Floydiv area.
- h. Though the chi of april IMZMROV informed Stefan PELTIKOV that he had found; a juide who would take nim to Greece if Stefan could arrive in Ploydiv by 7 May 1951.
- 5. On 6 hay milliably, Stafan FELTEROV and Spas RAIKIN left their unit. They travelled on foot to Varna, and from Varna to Plovdiv by train, arriving 7 May without incident. They were met by Wasil LAZARDV and his wife, Maria. LAZARDV took them immediately to a little woods near the village Bulastica and promised to send a friend of his with food and armament that same night. The signal for recognition was disunderstood and no contact was made.
- 6. The following merming the entire group went to Plevdiv in search of Vacil Lizuady. Day found him and his wid, as well as Stefan's whole, Boris Pilo Pov. All left immediately for barkove to find Petur NIFOLOV who would have further note of the Irudovaks. Emmedo Dillatov and Boris PELTIKOV were separated from the others and went to Branipole where they were located by Angel Bilotodov. AND USOFF weekt HaddiMOV to a hiding place near the vallage Barkova where the joined the other two Trudovaks. That night all three Tradovaks were teach over by Petur VIRGAN who gave them food and three rifler with scamping on.

- S. Petur Mikolo Land Ivan Todorov STULIMV used to Tridovake to doin the uorjani instead of fleeing to orece. Lo2 of also informed the fast he was planning to organize a Gorjani group in sold sold that the Tridovake should form the nucleus. The Trudovake refused and insisted enguing to Greece.
- 9. During the 11, 12, and 13 May the Trudovake received of sola Mogila by themselves without food and then decided to return to Playdiv and contact Stefan's father, Petur Filthou, as they had lost faith in Laladov. On the May Boris Politikov brought them food and ordered them to return to cola Mogila.
- 10. On 16 May Ivan NIKOLOV brought one Iliev 01007 to Sola Mogila who would take the Trudovaka to the Scrjani. The Trudovaka having lost hope of escaping to Greece had agreed to join the Gorjani. GIUST, who was to return the following day did not show up, and it was learned later that he had been arrested.
- 11. On 19 May DAMJANOV and Stefan FELT NOV went again to Plovity and met Vasil LAZAROV. TAZAROV again promised to find a guide for present and ordered the Trudovaks to return to Sola No ila. On 32 May Fetur IELREOV crount the news that Vasil TAZAROV had been arrosted on 19 May and on 26 May, his wife, Maria, had been arrosted. He also told them that one Stefan SIERAROV, a lawyer, from Sofia had arrived in Plovdiv and wished to join the Trudovaks in their flight to Greece. Petur DM DMA / saw some Security agents surveilling the lawyer and further contact was impossible.
- 12 From 26 May to 6 June the Trudovaks remained in sola Morila or other places in the vicinity and in wandering around the area their presence became known to the inhabitants.
- 13. On 7 June Boris PELTEROV advised them to go to Markovo and hide in Ivan NIKOLOV'S place where it would be easier to provide from with food. That asses evening they went to NIKOLOV's place and he explained to them that his brother, Petur, had been arrested, and they had decided to escape to over. The NIKOLOVS were to be joined by the brothers PLLTEOV, whose house had been placed under police surveillance. However, on 7 June Boris PELTETOV came to Gola Rogila and told the Trudovaka that his brother, fetur, did not consider the situation completely compromised and was reluctant to join the escape party.

 - 15. Informant states the Vasil Laza TOV is from the villige relation and is known to him. Laza TOV was a legionnairo until 1911, he was personated by the regime and spent some time in prison. After his release from prison Lazardy joined the Communist Youth Organization and apparently had a successful career in the "agit-prop" section. With the help of a relative, Nikolina DONKOVA, an old communist, Lazardy was promoted to NOO in the army.
 - 16. Subject states he never saw the Gorjani rebels, but he ofter heard of them and had listened to the Gorjani radio station broadcasts. On 27 May 1551 informant states he saw an aeroplana cruising in in the area of the village Ferdinandovo, Plovdiv, which was allegadly attacked by the Gorjanis.

 LAZAROV told the Trudevaks that the Gorjanis had three groups, one each in Plovdiv, Sliven and Sofis areas.
 - 17. In the village Belastica there were about 1250 inhabitants but only about 20 were communists. Informant did not knew of any anti-communist organization in the village.
 - 18. Informant did not know the brothers KIKOLOV previously. He rejects them as sold nationalists, energetic and honest. He never suspected them of all leation with the State Security and believes they had ample opportunity to hand them over to the Militia if the NIKOLOVS were so inclined.
 - 19. Informant also did not know Petur and Beris PSLEKOV. He thinks they are both anti-communist and therough nationalists. According to informant, Fetur PELTEKOV is the exuberant type, boasting and not very serious. Both PULLINGS blaned IAZARAV for all their trouble while they were in Bulgaria, but later in Orecce they defended him. The querrel between the MIKOLOVS and the PELTEKOVS was caused by mutual suspicion, mostly with respect to IALLEDV.

 The hardship and hunger endured during their flight to Orecce added to the original misunderstanding.
