Deregatory information was developed about subject's close associate, Dr. Jack M. M.KI, Jamuary 1959. A past supervisor of MOOS was Dr. Frederick S. HULGE, formerly OSS, possibly CF or RIS.

Eric County CP was trying to find someone without direct CP connections to participate in a committee to defend the CP against the Medurran Act. Subject is son of the head of the Soviet American Friendship Committee. (In 1946 subject's Mother, Elizabeth MOOS was Extentive Secretary of the Committee on Education, National Council of american-Deviet Friendship.) Paul SPORS was designated by Eric County CP to contact Carl MOOs to see if latter's house could be used as meeting place for persons who were being considered as members of committee to defend the CP against the McCarran Act.

(Paul SPORN was in contact with Mortimer SCHEER on 1 February 1962 re peace demonstration to be held in Cheektowaga, New York.)

Carl MOOS was in contact with Helen and Tobias SCHWARTZ and J. and Paul SPORN several times to discuss "peace" matters. November 61 - June 62. -- UBB-19845, 27 April 1965.

Carl MOOS is also known as Robert Moos IMANDT. He left Buffalo to attend medical conference in Japan, late August 1965. Returned 17 September 1965. MOOS made his travel arrangements through Chery Chase Travel, Inc. He wanted to attend the 23rd Congress of the International Physiological Congress in early September 1965 in Tokyo. Itinerary shown. -- DEE-26171, 13 October 65.

Association by Carl MOOS and his wife, Joan, with Tebias and Helen SCHWARTZ, Paul and J. SPORM, October 1962, Movember 1962, February 1961, May 1963, June 1963, August 1963, September 1963. (Paul SPORN was former Educational director of Krie County CP. In fall 1961, he and other Eric County CP leaders were in factional dispute with National and N.Y. District CP leadership which resulted in a split from the CP in late 1961, Subsequently, he was active in ferration of a new Marxist-Leninist Party, referred to in Buffaco as the Progressive Labor Movement (PLM). Carl and Joan MOOS paid dues and contributed to PiM, 1902, 1903. Carl MOOS was treasurer of Buffalo Chapter of S/AR, November 1962.

Meeting held at Carl MOOS' home on evening of 23 October 1902 to discuss speech of President Kennedy regarding the Cutan crisis.
