## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: IDEN A

- l. IDEN A telephoned IDEN B on 15 June 1966 who asked him to come to Madrid as soon as possible so that he could be back in San Juan before the 25th of June. The implication was that IDEN A should be back in San Juan in time to talk to a PERUMEN who was with the PERUMEN delegation to the Tenth Central American and Caribbean Games. (IDEN C, was medelegate to the Games).
- 2. IDEN A and IDEN P developed a plan that involved two action agents already inside PBRUMEN. One was to assassinate AMTRUG either by rifle fire or remote controlled radio activated explosives while the other agent was to establish a military base in the central part of PBRUMEN. Station Madrid 16-2 spoke with IDEN A who reported that he believed AMTHUG would topple within the next few months and that he already had a group inside PERUMEN.
- J. IDEN A was interviewed upon his return to San Juan where he reported that he did not have any firm evidence that AMTRUG would topple within the next few months but only that he intuitively believed that AMTRUG's downfall was imminent. He based this on reports that things were getting worse in PERUMEN and that the people were ready to revolt. He also based it on the fact that he now has two action agents 'of the same caliber as AMLASH inside PERUMEN who are ready to do his bidding.
- 4. TOEN A's 'agents' inside PERTUYEN are probably IDEN C, who might cooperate with IDEN B but not necessarily

with IDEN A. Further there is no firm evidence that IDEN C is against the present regime in PERUMEN. IDEN I is another possible contact. Again, other than some unsupported allegations there is no independent firm evidence that IDEN D is anti-regime.

- 5. IDEN A also claimed in Madrid that
  IDEN E had ment him a message and that he was considered
  a potential ally. He explained this in San Juan
  by snyang that during a press conference his name
  had been mentioned and that IDEN E replied that he
  considered IDEN A to be his friend. IDEN A rationalized
  that if IDEN E had not wanted to indicate in some way
  that he was 'with' IDEN A he would have taken this
  opportunity to blast him.
- intentions generally before I introduced him to AMEADGER/1. I had first asked him if he would mind reporting to us via a trusted PERUMEN exile now living in San Juan and, after I had identified AMEADGER/1, he replied that he knew him and respected and liked him, The three of us had a meeting and it was agreed that IDEN A would keep AMEADGER/1 completely informed of his plans and that AMEARGER/1 bould convey them to mee in PEPRIME. IDEN A refused to reveal the identities of his agents inside PERUMEN despite strong pressure. He also stated that IDEN F and IDEN G would have to know about his arrangement with AMEADGER/1 and with KUBARK. IDEN F and IDEN G, together with IDEN A, are the triumwirate of the JURE.

## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: AMPADGER-1

- 1. On this date, Subject called me from San Juan, Puerto Rico to report on his meeting with AMRANG-1 on 12 July. AMBANG-1 remained adamant coccerning his refusal to reveal the names of his sources inside Cuba. However, AMEADGER-1 believes that AMEANG-1 is in a better frame of mind than previously and he needs some added push to reveal the names.
- 2. AHRADGER suggested that Growery come to Puerto Rico to give AMBANG-1 that added push. AMBADGER-1 said that AMBANG-1 speaks fondly of Growery and he believes that Growery might convince AMBANG-1 to reveal the names. Alternatively, AMBANG-1 and AMBADGER-1 could come to Washington, D.C. for discussions with Growery.
- 3. I agreed to write AMRADGER-1 the details of processing his wife's citizenship. AMPADGER-1 wants to process his wife's citizenship in Montreal. I also agreed to look into the matter of transmitting money to his mother in Cuba at a rate of exchange more favorable than one to one.
