

SOLEMN OATH

1. I, , understand that I may be the recipient of information and intelligence which concerns the present and future security of our country and which belongs to our government. This information and intelligence, together with the methods of collecting and handling it, are classified according to security standards set by our government. I have read and understand the provisions of the espionage laws concerning the disclosure of information relating to the national defense and I am familiar with the penalties provided for the violation thereof.
2. I acknowledge that I do not now, nor will I ever possess any right, interest, title, or claim in or to any of the information or intelligence or methods of collecting or handling it which has come or will come to my attention by virtue of my connection with our government, but I will always recognize the property right of our government in and to such matters.
3. I do solemnly swear that I will never divulge, publish, or reveal either by word, conduct, or any other means any classified intelligence or knowledge except in the performance of my official duties and in accordance with the laws of our country, unless specifically authorized in writing, in each case, by our government.
4. I understand that no change in my relationship with our government will relieve me of my obligation under this oath and that the provision of this oath will remain binding upon me even after the termination of my services with our government.
5. I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion.
