1. AVICEL (Identity under separate cover), a staybehind principal agent of the Havana Station, has been assigned the post office box listed in (HPC) 559. He has also been trained in a TV system and will use the (Caracas) P.O. box to send TV messages in the event staybehind activities become necessary in Cuba. (6-17)

2. It is currently contemplated that when a message containing it is received at the (Caracas) post office box, it will be developed by the (Caracas) station and the contents relayed to Headquarters by cable for the preparation of a reply if one is necessary. The reply will either be pouches or cabled to (Caracas) for sending on to AVICEL in Cuba. (6-17)

3. It is requested that (the Caracas Station) advise the Cuban station of the return address which will be used in forwarding TV letters to AVICEL. (6-17)

4. You will be advised of the post office box of AVICEL at a later date. (6-17)
