RE SLOBODA CASE. WHILE IN LONDON MR. [redacted] <sup>06</sup> DISCUSSED CASE WITH  
[OUR STATION THERE] <sup>15-1</sup> AND WAS AGAIN TOLD THAT [redacted] <sup>24</sup> ASSISTANCE CANNOT  
BE EXPECTED UNLESS ADDITIONAL REASONS THAN THOSE STATED IN ATTACHMENTS  
TO YOUR LETTER TO BSSO, DATED 11 SEPTEMBER 1960, ARE SUBMITTED.  
THEREFORE REQUEST TO KNOW WHETHER [redacted] <sup>24</sup> AUTHORIZED TRANSMIT  
YOUR LETTER OF 30 SEPTEMBER 1960 AND ATTACHMENTS TO ITS [LONDON STATION] <sup>15-1</sup>  
AND HAVE LATTER USE SUBSTANCE PARAS 3 AND 4 OF THIS LETTER AS BASIS  
FOR REKEYING REQUEST FOR [redacted] <sup>24</sup> ASSISTANCE.

Above sent via SECURE TXN to Camp King on 7 October 1960. Col. Ross called  
me at 1100 hours 7 October 1960 and agreed to forwarding of above correspondence  
to [London Station] <sup>15-1</sup> provided his letter to us would not be released to [redacted] <sup>24</sup>  
in original form.
