## SYNOPSIS

Several individuals bearing same surname as SUBJECT were registered at the Hotel Waldorf Astoria during periods close to the first week of July 1959. One of these individuals, however, was registered before, during, and subsequent to the first week of July 1959.

GENERAL:

At New York, New York

On 13 August 1959, JOSEPH GEARY, Director of Security, Waldorf Astoria Hotel, was interviewed at his office, and through his contact was made with Miss M. F. CULLETON, Assistant Credit Manager. Miss CULLETON caused the guest files to be searched, and she provided the following information.

One HERMAN \_\_\_\_\_ was registered at the hotel between the dates 24 June and 21 July 1959; his address is 7200 Coldwater Canyon Drive, Beverly Hills, California. One G. J. \_\_\_\_\_ from Wayne, Indiana was registered at the hotel between the dates 14 and 17 July 1959. Mr. and Mrs. GEORGE W. \_\_\_\_\_, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, were registered between the dates 21 and 25 June 1959.

Thus, it was determined that HERMAN \_\_\_\_\_ was the only individual bearing the same surname as the SUBJECT who was in residence at the Waldorf Astoria during the first week of July 1959.
