Weetings with ARTHIF/1 on 15-16 September 1965

- 1. ANWHIP/1 was met by the case officer (using the name "Nr. Wills")
 in New York 15 and 16 September. The first meeting took place at
 the Du Midi Restaurant, 487 Street and 8 . and lasted from
 2115 until 2330 on 15 September. The second took place at the
 Taft Hotel and lasted from 1315 until 1430.
- 2. A/1 was told that we had no specific assignments for him on his forthcoming business trip to Europe and that he was not to contact initiate contact with officers at any of our He was instructed to send a cable to "gohn a. Breitheim, 6192 Apex Station, Washington, D.C." saying where he could be contacted if he should learn anything important and timely, such as the whereabouts of Che Guevara. It was also agreed that he could send an airmail letter to the same address if he should acquire #fifefffinformation that was perishable but could safely be sent by mail. In either case he would sign correspondence "Francisco".
- 3. A/l plans to depart for Europe about 20 September and to remain there three to four weeks before returning to New York. He plans to go first to Italy and spend a week to ten days in Rome and Milan. He will then probably proceed to Geneva. He may or may not go to Faris, where he has no specific business. He plans to go to Madrid for a day or two, not on business, but to see relatives who are there awaiting visas to the United States.

5. On 16 Se '-mha- a/1 provided the following information from a letter he had received from APTUIP/2 written 9 September:

- a. A/2 and his wife had lunch in Paris on 8 September with O/2 (UNSWAFTI/19 and "Pepin" Warward, the Favor of Havans. The latter was proceeding to Rome and expressed interest in section A/2 when he was in Furope, but A/2 did not provide details on N's trip or timing.
- b. A/2 had talked by telephone to IGIESTAS, a friend of a/l's from Havana, who again expressed interest in seeing A/l. IGIESTAS was staying at the Hotel Is Corzan, Jose Antonio 31, Esdrid. He did not indicate how long he would be in Europe or why he wished to see A/l.
- c. A/2 had seen the latest batch of jewelry from Havana to

 (UNSNAMU/19 for disposal in Europe and said it was very poor

 merchandise except for an unspecified number of cold coins.

 (The literal definition of the Spanish adjective was "shifty".)
- 6. A/1 said that he received no messages from AMIASW/1-2-3 except for continued requests from A/2 in Yadada ## (to #/1 vis Kismi) still in Havena and there has been no confirmation of the June rumour that he might be in trouble. A/1 considers it odd that he's had no word from AFLaqu/ since his return to Cubs earlier this year. 7. A/1 returned to New York 13 September after a trip of about a week to Sami + Junuty Puerto Rico (business) and Florida (pleasure). In Wami he heard a rumor to the effect he (f/1) sold Guben jewelry in Europe that had been brought there and given him by AVIACH/1. A/1 had shrugged it off---and said it was untrue. He said the rumor had started in Fadrid with a man named (FMU) MANYARRRITTA; and was given him in Kiami by KUSSO and Affecto FICT. 5/1 is still acitated by the failure of his two elderly female r.c. and believes relatives in Radrid to acquire visas of any kind to the

they are retting the brush-off. He will probably try to help them when he goes to Madrid at the end of his trip.

8. A/l appeared to be mer relaxed and in partial health. He said that he was very busy at work and that business is going well; this is one reason that he does not intend to remain in Europe too long this trip.

Therefore He wanted these meetings to continue his mattrices with us in the usual pattern, i.e. rectings before and after his trips to Europe. He probasuspects ably partials that our failure to give him any specific requirements and combined with instructions not to contact our stations is a result, at least in part, of his inconclusive LCFLUTTER in August. He did not complain, however, nor react strongly. He still anticipates a further LCFLUTTER on his return—in Spanish.
