

| <b>I.</b> At a 20 August 1961 meeting AMSHIP/2 was asked about a series of PERUVIANS (it is ali) who, he was told, are or have been in Rome. Included in the list at intervals were AMASH/1, 2, and 3. (BONCE comment: In accordance with a discussion with LANGELOCH during his recent trip to Rome,) AMSHIP/2 was given no further information and nothing about the fifteen men except their names.  |   |  |                                      |
| a. Subject did not respond re AMASH/3.<br><br>b. Subject had heard AMSHIP/1 and others mention AMASH/2, whom Subject does not know personally. He knew of him only that he has been in Paris a number of times and that he was said to be stupid.<br><br>c. Subject knows AMASH/1 well, although not as well as does AMSHIP/2, through whom AMSHIP/2 met AMASH/1. Subject described AMASH/1 as a very complicated person of conflicting and perhaps confused loyalties. Once, when AMASH/1 was so drunk and ill that he was heading for the bathroom to vomit, he kept shouting curses at the AMTHUG regime which "murdered my son." Sober, he is also critical of AMTHUG. But as soon as anyone else is similarly critical, AMASH/1 immediately defends AMTHUG and his government. AMSHIP/2 believes that AMASH/1 is emotionally and psychologically mixed up and does not know where he stands. |   |  |                                      |
| d. AMSHIP/2 knows why AMSHIP/1 sang AMASH/1 out. (He did not state the reason and was not asked.) He knew, however, only through what AMSHIP/1 volunteered, and not through being present at any meetings. When these occurred, if AMSHIP/2 chanced to be present, he left the room voluntarily and at the outset.  |   |  |                                      |

2. Regarding Ambassador Antonio CARRILLO Carrera (201-349956), AMHHP/2 feels sure that he is not presently selectable and is clearly pro-regime. (In the other hand, he is not happy in his job, complaining that he was not cut out to work constantly and under pressure, and would prefer a quieter post in western Europe. With some help from Subject, arranging lodgings, CARRILLO has gone to Benidorm, Spain, for most or all of the month of August. (At least Subject thinks that he is there.) AMHHP/2 was instructed to let us know whenever he is privy to the vacation plans of CARRILLO, or anyone else similarly placed, well enough in Havana and with the added proviso that he was not himself involved in the arrangements (Comment: So that, if a pitch seems reasonable, there will not be a danger of blow-back). As was reported earlier, it has been many months since CARRILLO has offered Subject any jewelry, and those transactions may have come to a close. CARRILLO did make a recent attempt to sell a painting to AMHHP/2.

3. In Cuban peace, AMHHP/2 has made repeated, discreet inquiries, alleging that he wants to send money to his wife's mother, who is dying of cancer. He states that it is impossible to get them. If it could be done, he says, [redacted] of (CIBA)41343, 23 Aug 1963 could do it. And he can't. 06

4. AMHHP/2 continues to express grave concern about AMHHP/1's sexual relationship with BUNKA of (CIBA)38996, 16 December 1964. Subject says that A/1 is no longer that he now wants a divorce in order to marry BUNKA. A/2 repeats that BUNKA is a woman of loose morals who was notorious as such even before she left Cuba. He stresses that A/1 tells her everything: "Alles, Alles, Alles!"

5. Finally, Subject says that information about A/1 which he had previously passed to BUNKA (oddly, he flatly refused to specify what information, although it is probable that it is the information about BUNKA A) had been leaked back somehow to AMHHP/1 several months ago. As a result, A/1 could have been put in a position to surmise that A/2 has a relationship with KUBAK, a fact which A/2 makes every effort to conceal from A/1 and everyone else, including A/2's wife. A/2 says that he has managed to divert any A/1 suspicions and smooth any ruffled feathers. However, because A/1 is his financial and business partner, and because A/2 is keenly aware of the importance of security, he asked that BUNKA guarantee that there will be no further leaks, that BUNKA accept A/2 info in confidence, or that BUNKA recognize that A/2, lacking such guarantees, cannot furnish any more information which might get him into trouble. Headquarters comments are requested.
