If a foreign-service officer is briefed, it may be assumed that he has been cleared and that he is thereafter considered a member of the DGI (at least by the DGI). On returning to Havana permanently, such a foreign-service officer briefed for a field assignment normally would be sent to DGI Headquarters rather than to the Minis.cy of Foreign Relations.
