- 1. The Direction General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence DGI) overseas field-station chief has no responsibility for physical or other security of the Cuban Embassy or Mission, nor does any member of his staff.
- 2. The DGI would not use a regular foreign-service officer in the field because he has not been cleared and briefed and is not, therefore, considered qualified for intelligence tasks. If a foreign-service officer is briefed, it may be assumed that he has been cleared and that he is thereafter considered a member of the DGI (at least by the DGI). On returning to Havana permanently, such a foreign-service officer briefed for a field assignment normally would be sent to DGI Headquarters rather than to the Ministry of Foreign Relations.
