

2. A query of the CUI machine file revealed several possibilities. Additional research in the personality files of the individual in showed two Cuban diplomats who may or may not be the unknown CIA officers. The two individuals are Orlando RAMON Gutierrez 201-23002 and Rafael ALFREDO 201-33674. Both men fit the general description and biographic data provided by AID/1 in his report. They were both recalled from Chile by the Cubans in December 1962 at the same time two other Cuban diplomats were sent home.			
3. We are forwarding photographs of the two men and request they be shown to AID/1 for possible identification. There is no record in Headquarters that AID/1 has ever seen these photos. They were not in the CUI photo file.
