FOR WAVE: REF A ADVISED THAT ONE FRANK (LNU), THE LONDON ASSURANCE, POST OFFICE BOX 260, KINGSTON, JAMAICA, SENT LETTER DATED 13 JULY 1965 TO ABE BUENO, C/O UNION DE SEGUROS, CALLE SAN LUIS NR. 48, SANTIAGO, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, WHICH MENTIONED THAT WRITER WROTE TO "XAVIER MELLA AT THE BEGINNING OF THE TROUBLES BUT I GUESS THESE LETTERS WOULD GO STRAIGHT INTO THE HANDS OF THOSE AT PRESENT HOLDING DOWNTOWN SANTO DOMINGO." REF B ADVISED ONE ABRAHAM "ABE" BUENO EMPLOYED UNION DE SEGUROS. REF C STATED FRANK (LNU) BELIEVED IDENT WITH FRANK COLLIN, BORN 10 JUNE 1918, CUMBERLAND, ENGLAND, AND RESIDENT KINGSTON, JAMAICA WHO WORKS FOR LONDON ASSURANCE. COLLIN WAS "SPECIAL GUEST" CUBAN GOVERNMENT 1962. XAVIER MELLA UNDOUBTEDLY IDENTICAL WITH FRANCISCO JAVIER MELLA PENA, IDENTIFIED BY *AMRUG-1* AS *COLLIN*.

2. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION OF ABRAHAM BUENO REVEALS HE PROBABLY IDEN ABRAHAM "ABE" OPINIO BUENO, BORN 17 MAY 1920, SANTIAGO, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC. HE FIRST ENTERED UNITED STATES AS EMIGRANT ON 7 JULY 1953 AT NEW YORK. ~~REDACTED~~

PLACE HAD MET BUENO AT JARAGUA HOTEL LATE 1958, AND DESCRIBED HIM AS WHITE, FIVE FEET EIGHT INCHES TALL, THIN BUILD, DARK COMPLEXION, BLACK HAIR AND THOUGHT ~~REDACTED~~ HE LIVED IN NEW YORK.
