1. IN RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS PARA 3 REF, [redacted] asset [redacted] Target [redacted] Summary [redacted]

[redacted] TOLD [redacted] THAT [redacted] HAD REFUSED TO SERVE AS INFORMANT FOR GOES ON SECURITY GROUNDS; CITED CASE OF STUDENT WHOSE REPUTATION RUINED IN UNIV A COUPLE OF YEARS AGO AFTER BEING COMPROMISED AS POLICE AGENT. [redacted] THEN RAISED POSSIBILITY OF WORKING FOR US. PROBABLY BECAUSE IT WELL KNOWN AROUND UNIVERSITY THAT [redacted] ENJOYS CLOSE RELATIONS WITH [redacted] CULTURAL ATTACHE, AND ONCE GIVEN [redacted] SCHOLARSHIP.

AT MEETING WITH [redacted] Station and [redacted] CU official ON 27 AUG, [redacted] TOLD HIM THAT WE HAVE DECIDED TO LET THE DUST SETTLE ON THE RUSSIAN PROFESSORS FLAP BEFORE FOLLOWING UP PITCH TO [redacted] Target, AND TO TAKE NO FURTHER ACTION THIS CASE UNTIL ADVISED.
