SUBJECT : Rolando CUEELA Secados

- 1. On 17 March 1961, Rolando CUBYLA Secadas telephoned from Havens, Cubs, to a personal friend, Carlos TEPEDINO Gonzales, in New York City. CUBELA asked TEPEDINO to place as order for two car springs and to deliver the springs to Hanuel "Manolito" PEREX. a member of the Cuban delegation to the Peace Conference held in Maxico City in early March 1931. FEREZ and "El Gordo Gerardo" reportedly lived at the Hotel Tudor, floom 1509, 304 Bast 42nd Stroat, Naw York.
- 2. The above information was given to a representative of this agency by Carlos TRFEDINO Conseles, a long-time contact. TEPEDINO is also a long-time acquaintence of CUBELA. The latter individual is President of the Cuban University Students Federation. President of the newly formed Revolutionary Vigilance Committee and delegate to the Peace Conference in Maxico, 5 to 8 March 1961. TEFEDINO, whose address is listed in this Agency's file as 580 Fifth Avenue, New York City, care of Isidore DOLINGER Diamonds, is a Cuban jawaler who formerly lived in Havana. He is also reported to be a partner in Corlete Incorporated, New York City.
- 3. According to TEPEDINO, Manual "Manualito" PEREZ is a member of Cuban G-2. TRPEDINO indicated he is uncertain as to whether his friend CUBBLA really desires the car springs ordered or is merely andnavoring to advise him, TEPEDINO, that PEREZ is connected with Cuben intelligence.
- 4. This Agency's files reflect no pertinent identifiable information on "El Gordo Cerardo". Namuel FEREZ may be identical with Manuel de Jesus PEREZ Hernandes, a secretary assigned to the Cuban Permanent Delegation to the United Nations. PEREZ has also been reported to be a member of G-2.
