The following is a summary of a recent report prepared by QUESADA/1 concerning his contacts with AMSHIP/1 in Madrid and developments concerning ANLASH/1 and AMSHIP/1:

1. QUESADA/1 was contacted by AMSHIP/1 in Madrid on 7 December 1963 and told:
 - a. The plans they had made in New York to get ANLASH out of PRAGUE for a meeting were no longer necessary since he had come out via Prague-Paris.
 - b. He was very optimistic about his meeting with ANLASH/1 because:
 - (1) ANLASH/1 definitely counts on at least 5 commandos and many other officers for the coup.
 - (2) ANLASH/1 himself is again active in the Army with the help of Raul Castro.
 - (3) The situation in PRAGUE is deteriorating and the right moment for the coup lies in the next few months.
 - (4) ANLASH/1's morale is high and he plans to return to PRAGUE soon.
 - (5) AMSHIP/1's people have contacted ANLASH/2 and ANLASH/3 in Madrid and knowing that "something was going on inside PRAGUE with a big Communist involved" (both said they did not give any names), AMSHIP/1's people were so excited over this that AMSHIP/1 himself was coming to Europe. (He arrived in Spain 2 or 3 days later).
 - c. AMSHIP/1 was offering:
 - (1) Any amount of small weapons and money for a big operation.
 - (2) A well trained group of men.
 - (3) A small size air force and navy
 - (4) Any sort of military action as complement of the coup inside
 - (5) Immediate diplomatic recognition of at least six Latin American Governments principally in Central America.
 - d. AMSHIP/1 would like to speak with QUESADA and they should take the next plane for Paris.
 - e. QUESADA told AMSHIP/1 everything was all right except for three points:
 - a. AMSHIP/1 was offering some class help - KUBAK.
 - b. They can get this help anytime without AMSHIP/1 or mediator.
 - c. AMSHIP/1 means very little without this help.
 - f. QUESADA/1 said he then suggested AMSHIP/1 inform KUBAK immediately what was going on.

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AMBIDY/1 was coming to Europe to see him. This apparently "Nick" did not do because the following day AMIADE/1 phoned AMIAS/1 in Paris to get his decision regarding the meeting with AMIAS/1. AMIAS/1 told AMBIDY/1 over the phone that he knew nothing about the meeting. AMBIDY/1 then took the next plane for Paris and later phoned QUOSPORT/1 to tell QUOSPORT that AMIAS/1 had decided not to meet with AMBIDY/1 for the present. AMBIDY/1 then left for New York City via Rome.

5. In the meantime AMBIDY/1 had come to Rome with three of his men apparently determined to see AMIAS/1. He sent Idea A to Madrid. Idea A told QUOSPORT/1 that AMBIDY/1 would like to speak with either AMIAS/1, AMIADE/1 or QUOSPORT/1 but that he could not come to Spain legally because of the Sierra Aranzazu incident. QUOSPORT/1 told Idea A that AMBIDY/1 was in New York City and AMBIDY/1 had no intention of meeting with AMIAS/1, et seq for the present, and that a conversation with QUOSPORT would not change anything. AMBIDY/1 insisted on trying to see AMIAS/1 and went to Paris with two of his men, one of whom is Idea B.
6. On 21 December QUOSPORT received a letter from AMBIDY/1 in New York telling QUOSPORT:
 - a. AMIAS/1 did not want to meet with AMBIDY/1 because of security.
 - b. AMIAS/1 will return to PR REPUBLIC at the end of January 1965.
 - c. AMIAS/1 has a fixed idea of what the solution is to the PRIDE problem.
 - d. AMBIDY/1 was coming to Europe shortly and he hoped the three of us could get together.
7. AMIAS/1 phoned me from Paris on the 22nd of December to tell me he would be here on 26 December and that he would try to stay at the Embassy. QUOSPORT told him about AMBIDY/1's letter.
8. On 22 December AMIAS/1 phoned me (QUOSPORT/1) and told me the following:
 - a. A meeting of all forces is necessary.
 - b. To tell AMIAS/1 that the "Americans" want to take him for the insulation (sic) and that with the failure of the Bay of Pigs he, AMBIDY/1, had had a very bitter experience, that was paid off in blood and jail and all because of the inconsistencies of American Policy.
 - c. That he has under his own control the necessary forces to produce, together with AMIAS/1, a definite action without any outside help and even against anyone's will.
 - d. He was going back to PRIDE for a few days on the 23rd of December to clarify a few things and then back to Paris.
 - e. That regardless of AMIAS/1's decision he wants to speak with QUOSPORT/1 anyway.
 - f. That he was sending Idea A to Madrid on 23 December as his contact man.
9. QUOSPORT/1 summed up his opinion as follows:
 - a. Regardless of whatever explanation is given, the situation is out of control.
 - b. In view of all the circumstances I do not think AMIAS/1 can go on much longer with this conspiracy without taking some definite action or being discovered and I feel that AMIAS/1 knows it.
 - c. I feel this is the moment to reconsider the whole business and come out with some specific plan to be worked out soon.

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4. Something has to be done within the next few days.
10. In view of QUICPORT, 1's close involvement with ANLASH/1, AGWHP/1, ANLAHE/2, ANLAHE/3, and ANSHIHY/1 please see that Bairrid is kept fully informed on any contacts between AGWHP/1 and ANLAHE/2, as well as AGWHP/1's travel plans to Europe.
