The available evidence on plans in reference cables, particularly in view of the conduct of *SECRET* here in Belgrade in its relations with *SECRET*, leads *SECRET* to agree with the views expressed in reference cables. It would be of value if this station could be advised of any other *SECRET* efforts of this kind that come to our attention. It might be that tactical possibilities would be presented by them.

2. There has come to our notice Helsinki Dispatch #266, dated October 21, 1952, reporting an attempt by *SECRET*, First Secretary of the Yugoslav Legation in Helsinki, to secure information concerning American views on the *SECRET* actions of the Communist Party. The tactics used remind us of *SECRET*; also, the subject of *SECRET*'s interest ties the matter in with *SECRET*. Just in case you have not seen the dispatch we are enclosing a copy for you. (We wonder whether the real intent of *SECRET* was not to feed the American source material back to us in Belgrade!) The expression "league with a club" might well be used in describing certain of our exchanges here in Belgrade!
