<p>1. Information received subsequent to the Reference shows that the fru FLORES mentioned in Para. 6 of the Reference is actually Edmundo FLORES Fernandez, leading Mexican agricultural economist (Source: LIFEAT). On 6 May 1966 a Station Officer asked FLORES if he had met Subject, saying simply that P33WING had learned that Subject had visited Mexico and since Subject was an agricultural specialist, FLORES would be a logical contact. FLORES replied that he did not know Subject and had not heard from him.</p> <p>2. LIFEAT also reported that Press Attache Nikolay Sergeevich LEONOV (201-132139) suggested that Subject talk to the CCI (cf Para. 6 of Reference) and take Ruslan Aleksandrovich TUCHNIN (201-205304) along with him, because "TUCHNIN can use these contacts, since he will be working here for four years."</p> <p>3. LIFEAT also reported that on 28 April 1966, when someone wished to see LEONOV, the latter's wife asked him to wait until the next day because LEONOV's "school friend" was visiting and LEONOV was all tied up with him. The Station assumes that Subject is LEONOV's "school friend."</p>
