1. Term and Project Charge. The subject individual has been engaged under oral contract for use under Project DICIRCUIT. The effective date of the oral contract is 19 June 1964 and shall continue thereafter until the termination of [redacted] tour of duty at BOE.

2. Citizenship. The subject is not a foreign national.

3. Compensation. The subject will be paid \$50.00 per month.

4. Taxes. For the tax year 1965 BOE will issue a Form 1099 to the sponsor at [redacted] showing UNEX as the source of payment. (For the tax year 1964 subject individual's salary did not exceed \$400.00.) Subject individual will report income reflected thereon as taxable and will be required to pay self-employment tax at the appropriate rate (presently 5.4%).

5. Quarters and / or Subsistence. No quarters and/or subsistence provisions are applicable in the case of subject individual.

6. Operational Expenses. No operational expenses will be incurred by subject individual.
