A.M. "MOTEL SITUATION"

Summary of Visit to: Ferguson, Mo.
 400 Main Street
 6000 Lee Highway
 Mixed Area, Mo.

1. Subject arrived in downtown St. Louis about 4:30 AM, 11 Nov 1968, and reported to Interrogation Room 204, FBI, 400 Main Street, 11 Nov 1968, by telephone, Lee Williams. His parole and probation are under the direction of the Probation and Parole Board of Missouri. He is a member of the Executive group of United Progressive Labora-SU. He was arrested on 25 April 1968 and released 7 June 1968. He spent all this time in the Central Party HQ together with the following 12 revolutionaries: John D. Bradley and his wife, both members of Villanova University, 1220 Obama, members of the Black Panther Party, Dr. George Jackson, undetermined, and another unidentified US national. The above mentioned individuals were still in LA when Subject left.

2. Subject stated that our target Alonso Contreras, a radio operator who entered clandestinely into Cuba from the US to assist the underground, turned up to the GL. Alonso informed USSR #1 of the clandestine operations; our operation was aimed first at the GL and the other USSR.

3. Subject stated that he is most anxious to continue the contact with representatives of US agencies in order to render a full report of the conditions of some of the emergency groups in USA. Subject is known to English and French and is personally acquainted with our radio and television Ambassador in Moscow. He also wants to contact someone which is his code name of a liaison agent for the underground in the US.

4. Subject was extremely nervous and excited and requested that he be allowed to rest for a few days before subject is reinterviewed.
