One of his primary tasks on this infiltration was to contact and to recruit AMTRUNK-10 as an internal P/A. AMTRUNK-10 hid AMICE-14 in his home for several days during which time AMTRUNK-10 agreed to work with AMICE-14 in MHAPRON activity.</p>		
<p>2. INDICATE WHETHER SUBJECT COULD BE TURNED OVER QUICKLY AND IN A SECURE MANNER TO ANY RESPONSIBLE CASE OFFICER FOR HANDLING. SECTION II

MOTIVATION AND CONTROL

1. EXPLAIN SUBJECT'S MOTIVATION. (Do not use code words such as "spies", "agents", etc.) Subject is a charter member of an anti-Batista revolutionary organization which, since its inception has been in conflict with Fidel Castro's own "26th of July" movement. Subject has been both anti-Castro and anti-Communist since the mid-1950's. Subject, like many others who rose to high rank through their efforts in the fight against Batista, feels that Castro has subverted the original aims of the Revolution and has handed the country over to International Communism. Subject has retained his control over the military.

2. INDICATE WHAT CONTROL, IF ANY, EXISTS OVER THE SUBJECT. (If no control, or if there is a lack of real control, explain.)

Little control, if any, exists over the Subject. He has an S/W system but has written to his WAVE accommodation address only once since his recruitment in August 1963. Any control over Subject which exists would come from AMLASH-1, a Headquarters internal asset, within whose group ANTRUNK-10 is active.

Para 1, Section II (cont.)--rank of Comandante but has been relegated to a minor post in INRA. Within the confines of his present official position, Subject can do little to help his country. As a conspirator and member of a potential coup group with ODYOTE backing, Subject feels that he can help to restore the original democratic aims of the anti-Batista revolution by deposing Fidel Castro.
