SYNOPSIS

SUBJECT - MARTIN ISAACS aka: MICHAEL ISAACS aka: MICHEL IZIKZS - was born 12 December 1904 in Hungary. He is currently employed as a supervisor of transportation, Special Services Section, DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE, CITY OF NEW YORK. SUBJECT received derivative citizenship from his father - MARTON IZIKZS - born 12 March 1874 in Hungary and naturalized at the New York Supreme Court 8 February 1915. SUBJECT married ELEANOR BANKS; they have a daughter, JOAN ROSE ISAACS, born in Manhattan 22 February 1941. SUBJECT currently resides at 1669 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y. In a permanent voters registration form, SUBJECT gives his name as MICHAEL ISAACS of 1669 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y. However, he has been employed with the DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE since 1938 as MARTIN ISAACS. Credit at New York, N.Y. clear.

BIRTH & CITIZENSHIP:

At New York, N.Y.:

On 28 January 1964, the records of the Bronx County BOARD OF ELECTIONS, 851 Grand Concourse, reflected that SUBJECT - MICHAEL ISAACS aka: MARTIN ISAACS aka: MICHEL IZIKZS - of 1669 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y. was born 12 December 1904 in Hungary. He claims derivative citizenship from his father, MARTON IZIKZS, naturalized 8 February 1915 in the Southern District Court of New York.

In a permanent voter registration form, dated 1957, MICHAEL ISAACS claimed fifty years in New York State and sixteen years at 1669 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y.

EMPLOYMENT:

At New York, N.Y.:

On 30 January 1964, a review of the records of the Department of Personnel, CITY OF NEW YORK, 299 Broadway, reflected that MARTIN ISAACS, born 12 December 1904 in Hungary, is currently employed as a supervisor of transportation for the Special Services Section of the DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE, CITY OF NEW YORK, 42 Franklin Street. He was appointed as a social worker for the DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE on 15 March 1938. He was promoted to assistant supervisor on 16 March 1954, and later to his current position as supervisor of transportation.

CREDIT:

At New York, N.Y.:

On 28 January 1964, a review of the records of the CREDIT BUREAU OF GREATER NEW YORK, INC., reflected a report, dated 22 September 1961, regarding MARTIN ISAACS (ELEANOR), 1669 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, New York, who is employed with the DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE, 42 Lafayette Street, New York, N.Y.

The credit record contained only one routine credit inquiry. No bank, trade, litigation was recorded, and nothing unfavorable.

GENERAL:

At New York, N.Y.:

On 3 February 1964, naturalization records of the New York Supreme Court, New York County, 31 Chambers Street, reflected a petition for naturalization #44850, contained on page 250, Volume 181, which pertains to one MARTON IZIKZS of 1665 Park Avenue, New York, N.Y., and disclosed the following information:

IZIKZS was born 12 March 1874 at Tartaltz, Hungary. His occupation was given as shoemaker.

He immigrated to the United States from Fiume, Hungary on 17 October 1908, and arrived in the United States at New York City 10 November 1908.

He filed a Declaration of Intention for United States citizenship on 16 December 1911 at the New York Supreme Court.

His wife was listed as ESTHER IZIKS, nee ZDNER, and she was born in Hungary. They resided with their children at 1665 Park Avenue, New York, N.Y.

MICHEL, born 10 November 1904 in Hungary.

HELEN, born 2 March 1909 in New York.

PAULY, born 3 December 1910 in New York.

Citizenship:

IZIKS was admitted to United States citizenship on 8 February 1915.

On 3 February 1964, the records of the NEW YORK DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, 125 Worth Street, were reviewed and reflected that a daughter, JOAN ROSE ISAACS was born in the JEWISH MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, Manhattan, on 22 February 1941 to MARTIN ISAACS, thirty-six years old, born in Hungary, and ELEANOR BANKS, thirty-one years old, born in the United States - place not indicated. MARTIN ISAACS occupation was listed as a social worker with the DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE. His home address was given as 1645 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y. The couple had no previous children.

Records of the SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM, 205 East 42 Street, were reviewed on 30 January 1964 and reflected that SUBJECT - MARTIN ISAACS - registered for Selective Service on 16 October 1940. Birth data was given as 12 December 1904 in Hungary. He stated he was a United States citizen living at 1645 Grand Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y. His mother was listed as ESTHER ISAACS, 1710 Montgomery Avenue, the Bronx, N.Y. His description was noted as 5'7", 145 pounds, brown hair, blue eyes and dark complexion.
