We feel we should disseminate this data since we have previously disseminated the information we received from Yuri Nosenko regarding the assassination even though we recognized some of the data was not subject to proof, particularly, that occurring within the Soviet Union. We feel that by documenting Shamrock as a "confidential informant, contact with whom has been insufficient to establish his reliability," we will alert other agencies that the information has not been established as true.

We have received information from numerous other sources that the Soviets did mourn the death of President Kennedy and that Soviet leaders felt they could work with President Kennedy.
