NEAR EAST - AFRICA BRIEF

(INFO IN SLANTS. RELATING INFO RELATABLE TO [Redacted])

1. CYPRUS: PEACE APPEARS TO BE SLOWLY REFORMING TO CYPRUS WITH ONLY A FEW EXCHANGES OF GROUND OCCURRED 20 DEC.

REPRESENTATIVES OF BRITISH, GREEK, AND TURKISH GOVERNMENTS AND OF TWO CYPRIOT COMMITTEES HAVE BEEN BROUGHT TOGETHER IN POLITICAL LIAISON COMMITTEE. BRITISH HAVE FAILED TO REESTABLISH JOINT BRITISH-GREEK-TURKISH PATROLS TO POLICE CEASE-FIRE. BRITISH PATROLS HAVE OCCUPIED ADDITIONAL STRONG POINTS BETWEEN THE GREEK AND TURKISH QUARTERS IN NICOSIA.

BOTH ETHNIC COMMITTEES DISCOUNT POSSIBILITY OF RETURNING TO POLITICAL STATUS QUO ANTE. PRESIDENT MAKARIOS, WHO ANTICIPATES SUPPORT OF ATHENS, CONTINUES TO CALL FOR REVISING CONSTITUTION WHICH HE TERMS "UNWORKABLE."

LEADERS FOR REJECTION OF BOTH GREEK AND TURKISH GOVERNMENTS ON ISLAND--INCLUDING THE TWO MILITARY COMMANDERS--IN FAVOR OF UNILATERAL BRITISH GUARANTEE OF CYPRUS INDEPENDENCE.

TURKISH CYPRIOTS, WITH AMERICA'S SUPPORT, HAVE REITERATED THEIR DEMANDS FOR SEPARATION OF ISLAND. TURKISH FOREIGN MINISTER ERKIN HAS SAID PARTITION IS ONE OF SEVERAL POSSIBILITIES BUT MAINTAINS THAT SOME "RADICAL" SOLUTION IS NECESSARY. (OSNY)

2. KENYA-SOMALIA: STEPPLE BETWEEN KENYA AND SOMALIA OVER CONTROL OF KENYA'S NORTHEASTERN REGION BEGINS LIKELY TO SHARPEN.

SOMALI TERRORISTS HAVE BEEN PARTICULARLY ACTIVE SINCE KENYA BECAME INDEPENDENT OF BRITAIN ON 12 DEC. LAST WEEK KENYA GOVERNMENT'S DECLARING STATE OF EMERGENCY INDICATES IT BELIEVES IT MUST REACT DECISIVELY TO ACTIVITIES OF SOMALI INHABITANTS AND CROSS-BORDER RAIDERS.

KENYATTA REPORTABLY SAID KENYAN FORCES WILL NOT HESITATE TO PURSUE ACROSS SOMALI BORDERS, SINCE THIS WOULD PERMIT SOMALIS TO INTERNATIONALIZE SITUATION, PERHAPS BY APPEAL TO UN. OBSERVERS ARE SKEPTICAL KENYAN AUTHORITIES CAN CONTROL SITUATION BY PATROLLING THE FIVE-MILE-BAND "DEAD ZONE"

CHINESE INVASION OF OCT 1962. AS IN MOST WEST INDIAN VOTERS APPARENTLY DID NOT IDENTIFY COMMUNIST CANDIDATE WITH ANY FOREIGN AID INFLUENCE.

PARTY STRENGTH THIS CONTEST WILL BOOST MORALE OF INFLUENTIAL WEST BENGAL, COMMUNIST PARTY WHICH FACTUALIZED BY SQUABLING BETWEEN LEFTIST LEADERS, WHO CONTROLLED PARTY BEFORE CHINESE ATTACK BUT WERE JAILED AFTERWARD, AND RIGHTISTS WHO SUCCEEDED LEFTISTS TO HIERARCHY. MORE RECENTLY BOTH FACTIONS LEADERS INTERESTED IN DEGREE OF RECONCILIATION WERE ABLE UNITE SUPPORTING SUCCESSFUL BY ELECTION CANDIDATE.
